
Canine Influenza Virus (CIV) is on the rise—don't let your best friend get sick.

Dogs are at higher risk when visiting:

- Dog parks
- Kennels
- Pet shows/sporting events
- Boarding facilities
- Doggie day care
- Groomers

Canine influenza is a highly contagious respiratory disease that spreads easily from dog to dog or is transmitted indirectly through bowls, toys, clothes, or hands of the owner. Unlike human flu, which is seasonal, canine influenza can strike all-year round.

The growing prevalence of CIV H3N2 and H3N8*




