

HOW TO CLEAN YOUR CAT'S EARS

Regular ear care can help keep your pet's ears healthy. That said, not all pets need their ears cleaned on a regular basis; ear cleaning should only be performed when there is a medical condition or presence of debris that warrants an ear cleaning. Consult your veterinarian if you have questions or concerns.

BE ADVISED

Cat's ears are more sensitive than dogs. We recommend cleaning their ears less forcefully and less frequently than for a dog. This technique will help you gently clean your cat's ears.



STEP 1

START WITH A BUNCH OF COTTON BALLS AND YOUR EAR CLEANER.

(For cats scared of the bottle, you can perform Steps 1 and 2 where your cat cannot see you.)



STEP 2

SATURATE A COTTON BALL WITH THE EAR CLEANER.



STEP 3

GENTLY PLACE THE SATURATED COTTON BALL INTO THE EAR CANAL OPENING.

(Do not push the cotton ball down into the canal.)



STEP 4

MASSAGE THE EAR VERY GENTLY FOR 15-30 SECONDS.



STEP 5

REMOVE THE COTTON BALL AND ALLOW CAT TO SHAKE ITS HEAD.



STEP 6

REPEAT IF THE COTTON BALL IS FULL OF DEBRIS. (Follow steps 2-5 until clean.)



STEP 7

USE A DRY COTTON BALL TO WIPE OUT ANY DEBRIS AND EXCESS CLEANER.
